

The Double EORI Strategy

How to manage inventory across the UK & EU Channel without getting blocked.

1 The New Reality

Since Brexit, the UK and EU are distinct customs territories. A single "GB" EORI number no longer grants you access to European customs processing.

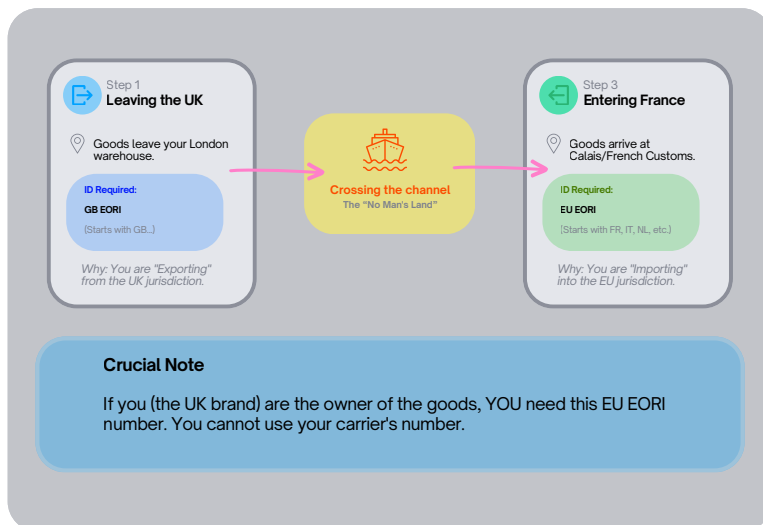


The Risk

If you move stock to a 3PL in France using only a GB EORI, your goods will be **stopped at the French border** because the "Importer of Record" is unrecognized.

2 The Flowchart Strategy

Scenario: A UK Brand sending stock to a French Warehouse



3 How to Fix It

Since Brexit, the UK and EU are distinct customs territories. A single "GB" EORI number no longer grants you access to European customs processing.

- 1 **Keep your GB EORI**
Use it for all UK exports.

- 2 **Register for one EU EORI number**
Apply in the first country you enter (e.g., France).



Result

That single EU EORI (e.g., FR...) is now valid for all 27 EU member states. You do not need a separate one for Germany or Italy.
